UMCDF Update

- **Processed 551 rockets on Jan. 17, making it the 15th best day of GB rocket processing in chem demil history.**
- **Washington Group International has been awarded a 2005 Oregon Governor's Occupational Safety and Health award.**
- Sustained nearly 20 hours of rocket processing Jan. 17.
- Long-term corrective actions from the December safety stand down are being completed.
- Safely protecting all depot workers, the general public and the environment remain the depot's top priorities.
- Precision and proficiency vs. production are the focus for our people, plant and procedures.
