

Milestone Dates

- Chemical weapons storage began in 1942
- Construction of TOCDF began in 1989
- Disposal operations began in 1996
- Complete destruction of GB nerve agent-filled munitions on March 15, 2002
- Complete destruction of VX nerve agent-filled munitions on June 3, 2005

TYPES OF CHEMICALS	POUNDS	% of AGENT DESTROYED
GB nerve agent	12,101,600 (44%)	100%
VX nerve agent	2,712,600 (10%)	100%
Mustard agent	12,417,600 (46%)	0%

TOCDF Update

- Decontamination and other plant changeover activities in preparation for the TOCDF Mustard Agent Destruction Campaign continue.
- Work continues to modify two storage igloos that will be used in support of the sampling operations for the mustard-filled ton containers (TCs) in preparation for the disposal of the mustard TCs. The work is 40 percent complete, including installation of the glove boxes and preparations for utility connections.
- You are invited to attend the final public information session for the TOCDF. This session will be held at the Tooele City Hall for you to learn about the plans for future disposal of the DCD mustard agent stockpile.
