TOCDF mercury monitoring testing

After completion of the Tooele Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (TOCDF) Metal Parts Furnace (MPF) Mini-Burn, EG&G officials are now conducting a test to demonstrate accuracy and effectiveness of the MPF exhaust monitoring for mercury.

The RATA, or Relative Accuracy Test Audit, is required under the TOCDF operating permit. This test involves conducting two independent sampling series to confirm the TOCDF's sampling method of quantifying any mercury concentration in furnace exhaust is effective and accurate.

Mustard agent vapor detected in storage igloos at DCD

In separate routine monitoring operations workers had identified four leaking mustard agent-filled ton containers.

The earth-covered storage structures were filtered and no vapor escaped to the environment. Tooele county officials were notified and there was no danger to surrounding communities.
