


### ANCA employees safely store, move agent-filled munitions

### *Ton Container processing nears milestone Contractor making progress reducing stockpile*

More than 62 percent, nearly two-thirds, of Anniston's mustard agent-filled Ton Containers have been processed at the Anniston Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (ANCDF). Each container is almost seven feet long and holds approximately 170 gallons of mustard agent. A conveyor is used to move the containers from the ANCDF unpack area to processing bays where robotic equipment drains the agent prior to further processing in ANCDF furnaces. (Jackson)

#### Key Messages

- ◆ The Anniston chemical munitions stockpile is safely stored and maintained by the employees of the Anniston Chemical Activity (ANCA) under the command of Lt.Col. Willie J. Flucker.
- ◆ Disposal is safer than indefinite storage.
- ◆ Since 1990, more than 24,410 tons of chemicals and more than 2,531,800 U.S. munitions have been safely incinerated.
- ◆ The U.S. Army *IS* committed to the safety of the community, the environment, and the work force.

#### Anniston Milestones

- ◆ **July 2, 2009 ~ May 5, 2011:** The ANCDF team has processed **276,142** mustard-filled munitions and **168,045** mustard gallons.
- ◆ **July 23, 2006 ~ December 24, 2008:** All **219,374** VX agent munitions and **196,925** gallons of VX nerve agent are safely demilitarized by ANCDF employees.
- ◆ **August 9, 2003 ~ March 2, 2006:** All **142,428** GB munitions and **96,078** gallons of GB nerve agent safely demilitarized.
- ◆ **1997 ~ 2003:** Westinghouse Anniston constructs and tests the ANCDF.
- ◆ **1997:** U.S. ratifies Chemical Weapons Convention, an international weapons treaty.
